## Senior Club Coach

The aim of the Senior Club Coach is to provide sailing development opportunities for all within the club. These development opportunities could include advertised coaching sessions or Informal coaching during normal club sailing. During the winter months there could be talks and demonstrations.

The purpose is to promote a love of both racing and cruising and thereby increase participation levels. Members who are progressing in their sailing are more likely to become and remain engaged.

## The Senior Club coach will

- 1. Be responsible for the recruitment of suitably qualified Club Coaches.
- 2. Work with the Training School to coordinate activities.
- 3. Work with the Transition Manager to support newly-qualified members
- 4. Be a member of the Sailing Committee

The role will be suitable for a good club sailor who is comfortable coaching the majority of members.

## You will need to be.

- 1. Approachable and patient
- 2. Have the ability to spot areas for improvement in other member's sailing and tactfully suggest improvements.
- 3. Have good organisational skills for running coaching sessions.
- 4. Be aware of safeguarding issues when working with juniors.

## You will be.

- 1. Supported by the Sailing Secretary.
- 2. Offered a place on a Race Coaching Level Two if needed.
